Peab builds an extended stay hotel in Norrköping

Peab has been commissioned to build an extended stay hotel in Inre hamnen in Norrköping. The customer is Mannersons Fastighets AB and the contract is worth SEK 101 million.

The project encompasses construction of a residential building at an angle with 71 apartments. The building will consist of six floors with apartments from one to four rooms. Part of the building will have a roof terrace and the facade will be made of concrete and wood. The extended stay hotel will be built according to Miljöbyggnad, level Silver.

“We’re pleased and proud to contribute with our expertise to the building of more homes for Norrköping residents. We look forward to further developing the exciting city borough Inre hamnen together with Mannersons Fastighets AB,” says Anders Bergeling, Region Manager Peab.

The project is a traditional contract. Construction is planned to start in September 2023 and is expected to be completed in January 2025.

The project will be order registered in the third quarter 2023.
