Peab builds retirement home in Falun

Peab has been commissioned to build a new retirement home in Falun. The customer is Sehlhall and the contract is worth SEK 177 million.

The retirement home will have two floors and contain 80 apartments, common areas and a dining room for a total area of 6,200 m².
