Peab renovates dock at Haakonsvern in Bergen

Peab has been commissioned to renovate the dock at Haakonsvern Naval Base in Bergen. The customer is Forsvarsbygg and the contract is worth NOK 120 million.

The equipping dock at Haakonsvern Naval Base will be renewed so that the dock will suit the Royal Norwegian Navy's new ship structure. The dock was built in 1960, has a front length of 190 meters, is between ten and twelve meters wide and made of concrete.

"We have previously worked together with Forsvarsbygg and this project is evidence of their confidence in us. This is a very exciting project regarding both the actual construction work and in that we are furnishing Forsvarsbygg with better use of the dock," says Johan Hansson, Region Manager at Peab.

Peab's job entails concrete renovation and reinforcement of the existing dock as well as ocean work that includes dredging the harbor basin. The project also includes erecting two new dock buildings, electrical work and establishing technical infrastructure for the dock.

The project is a general contract. Construction will start at the end of 2020 and the project is expected to be completed by spring/summer 2022.

The project will be order registered in the fourth quarter 2020.
