Peab builds production plant in Lund

Peab has been commissioned to build a production plant for pharmaceuticals in Lund. The customer is Wihlborgs Fastigheter AB and the contract is worth SEK 125 million.

The building will be located in Hasslanda industrial park and will contain offices, storage, production and tech space. The total area will be 6,400 m² allocated on two floors and the building will be built according to Miljöbyggnad Silver.

“We’re proud to have been entrusted with this construction project that contributes to the continued development of Hasslanda. This is a good example of our locally produced community building,” says Olle Olsson, Region Manager Peab.

“We look forward to developing this modern production plant for our long-term lessee Inpac together with our contractor Peab. Hasslanda is one of Lund’s most attractive industrial parks with good communications and development opportunities,” says Andreas Ivarsson, Head of Project and Development at Wihlborgs.

The project is a turnkey contract. Construction will begin in October 2022 and occupation is planned for the fourth quarter 2023.

The project will be order registered in the third quarter 2022.
